Transform your LinkedIn profile into a powerful tool that attracts recruiters and opportunities.

1. Professional Profile Photo

- Use a high-quality headshot with professional attire
- Smile and make eye contact with the camera
- Use a clean, simple background
- Profiles with photos get 21x more views!

2. Compelling Headline

- Go beyond your job title - showcase your value proposition
- Include keywords relevant to your target roles
- Example: "Product Manager | Driving Innovation in FinTech | Ex-Google"
- You have 220 characters - use them wisely

3. About Section That Sells

- Write in first person to create connection
- Lead with your unique value and what you're passionate about
- Include specific achievements with metrics
- End with a call-to-action how to reach you
- Aim for 3-5 short paragraphs ~2000 characters

4. Experience Section with Impact

- Use bullet points to highlight accomplishments, not just duties
- Include metrics and results wherever possible
- Start each bullet with action verbs
- Add media presentations, projects, articles to showcase your work

5. Skills & Endorsements

- List at least 5 key skills maximum 50
- Put your most important skills at the top
- Request endorsements from colleagues and managers
- Skills help you appear in recruiter searches

6. Recommendations

- Aim for 3-5 strong recommendations
- Ask specific colleagues who can speak to your impact
- Offer to write recommendations for others first

7. Stay Active

- Post or share content regularly 2-3x per week
- Engage with others' posts through meaningful comments
- Turn on "Open to Work" when job searching
